

“TAKE 10”- Worship While Away! (Sunday, January 27, 2019)

Share: The voice of God resounds upon the water.
The Spirit of the Lord hovers over the stream.
The Son of God is named, “Beloved.”

Read these words from a hymn today *You Are Mine*

Chorus:

Read this scripture from worship: Isaiah 43:1-7 (The Message)

¹⁻⁴ But now, GOD’s Message, the God who made you in the first place, Jacob,
the One who got you started, Israel: “Don’t be afraid, I’ve redeemed you.
I’ve called your name. You’re mine.

When you’re in over your head, I’ll be there with you.

When you’re in rough waters, you will not go down.

When you’re between a rock and a hard place, it won’t be a dead end—

Because I am GOD, your personal God, the Holy of Israel, your Savior.

I paid a huge price for you: all of Egypt, with rich Cush and Seba thrown in!

That’s how much you mean to me! *That’s* how much I love you!

I’d sell off the whole world to get you back, trade the creation just for you.

⁵⁻⁷ “So don’t be afraid: I’m with you. I’ll round up all your scattered children,
pull them in from east and west. I’ll send orders north and south: ‘Send them back.
Return my sons from distant lands, my daughters from faraway places.
I want them back, every last one who bears my name, every man, woman, and child
Whom I created for my glory, yes, personally formed and made each one.’”

Talk together, responding to these questions:

- What are some images and effects of water?
- How is water related to God's renewing work?
- At this time in your life, where and when do you need to remember God's words, "I will be with you"? (Isaiah 43:2)
- How does baptism give us identity?
- In these unsettling times, how does "remember your baptism" affirm both our belonging to God and our calling by God?
